

First-Aid Kit Checklist

Keep these items handy in or near the barn to be prepared for an equine health emergency. Check your supplies every few months to make sure everything is still in good condition and ready to use.

- Your veterinarian's name and phone number
- Directions to your vet's clinic and major referral hospital
- Address and directions to your location to give to your vet
- Equine Vitals Sheet and deworming/vaccination history
- Thermometer and lubricant (such as petroleum jelly)
- Antiseptic scrub (betadine or chlorhexidine base)
- Bandage material
- Antibiotic ointment
- Sterile saline eye wash
- Flashlight/headlamp
- Scissors
- Sharp knife, wire cutters, pliers
- Stethoscope
- Dose syringe
- Tape (white and duct)
- Latex gloves
- First aid handbook
