


QUICK METHOD

This is a quick way to attach the tail. It's good for horses that don't swish their tails excessively, and you can leave the central braid in the tail throughout the show.





- Separate a section of hair at the bottom of the tailbone in the center of the tail and divide into three parts. Braid the hair for about 12 inches, then secure the braid with a rubber band.
- Slip the braid through the fake tail loop.





- Loop the braided hair through itself to form a knot with the fake tail loop in the middle of it. Tighten the knot and lay the braided section on top of the fake tail.
- Wrap a piece of electrical tape around the fake tail and braided real tail hair.
